



HOW TO GET A TX LIFE INS. LICENSE

Steps to get a license:

1. Study & Pass Exam
2. Get Fingerprinted
3. Send in Application

1. Study & Pass Exam

- Sign up for a study course online and complete it. There are countless options to choose from online but we have one that provides discount through AD Banker www.adbanker.com. They offer a discount code for our agents (1652529) which knocks \$90 off whatever package you select at checkout.
- To learn about how and where to take your exam when you're ready, go to [Pearson VUE](#) and download the candidate handbook. Schedule your exam as soon as you can, some testing centers can be booked weeks out. The [Pearson VUE website](#) also provides links to exam outlines and an ESL (English as a second language) request form.
- Veterans can be reimbursed the fees for exams taken on or after February 1, 2019. Veterans who have passed Texas insurance exams can [apply to the U.S. Department of Veterans Affairs](#) to get the exam fee reimbursed.

2. Fingerprint background check

- Most people who apply for a license must: (1) get a fingerprint background check from [IdentoGO](#), and (2) send us a copy of the [IdentoGO](#) receipt showing that their fingerprints were sent to the Texas Department of Public Safety.
- Some people can ask for an exemption from getting a fingerprint background check. To learn more, see the [Texas Administrative Code](#).
- To schedule a fingerprint appointment, go to [IdentoGO](#) or call 888-467-2080. Use **service code 11G6QF** when making the appointment.

3. Application: Agent

- **To apply for an agent license:**
 - **You must pass the exam before applying.** If you apply before passing the exam, you will need to: (1) send a new application after you pass the exam, and (2) pay the application fee again.
 - You must complete your fingerprints and then submit an application within one year of passing the exam or you will need to retake the exam.
 - You must apply online by using [Sircon](#) or the [National Insurance Producer Registry](#). The application fee is **\$50**.
